

APPENDIX A TO BY-LAWS

TIME PERIODS FOR ACTION

7.01 A Time Periods for Action

To the extent practicable, the following time periods shall apply in scheduling and taking actions with respect to interviews, hearings, and appellate reviews:

- (1) Interviews: Interviews will be scheduled within 60 days of the decision of the MPSC-PCSC or full MPSC that entitles the Member to the interview.
- (2) Hearings: Hearings will be scheduled not less than 7 days nor more than 60 days from the date of UNOS' receipt of the request for hearing.
- (3) Hearing Committee Report: The Hearing Committee report will be issued within 30 days after preparation of the hearing record.
- (4) Action on Hearing Committee Report: The MPSC or Board of Directors, as applicable, will consider and act on the report of the Hearing Committee within 30 days following receipt of the report.
- (5) Appellate Review: Appellate reviews will be scheduled not less than 30 days nor more than 90 days from the date of UNOS' receipt of the request for appellate review.
 - (a) Action Taken: In the event the Appellate Review Body refers a matter back to the Hearing Committee, the Appellate Review Body will make its decision with respect to the matter within 14 days after receipt of any recommendations from the Hearing Committee.
- (6) Board of Directors Action: The Board of Directors will render its decision within 90 days after the conclusion of hearing and appellate review proceedings.
